CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Phillip Pandal [Young Heritage](#) Award 2017 City of South Perth Historical Society Inc.

1. Open to all students residing in or attending school or college in the City of South Perth.
2. Write a factual historical story relating to the City of South Perth using as inspiration a photograph that portrays the subject. The story cannot be fictional. Suggested Themes: My favourite heritage or historical place, e.g. buildings and places of the Mends Street Heritage Precinct, distinctive object, place or person connected to a suburb of South Perth.
History can be anything that happened before today, not necessarily a long time ago.
3. Entrants are encouraged to use a clear photograph which they themselves have taken or from their collection. If a photo taken by someone else is used, the source must be acknowledged.
4. The written component must be the original work of entrant and must relate to factual aspects of heritage and history relevant to a suburb of the City of South Perth and boundary rivers.
6. The length of the entry should be between 100 and 800 words, having regard to the age of the entrant.
7. Entries must include a bibliography stating the sources from which information in the entry was obtained.
8. Only one entry per student. Joint entries are not permitted.
9. The entry is to be on quality paper.
10. Only one photo, which must be either portrait or landscape, colour or black and white. Photo paper is preferred. The photo may be a photocopy.
11. The written entry, photo and attached entry form must be lodged on Friday, 26 May at Heritage House, 111 Mill Point Road, (*corner* Mends Street), South Perth between 10 am and 5 pm. Alternatively, digital entries will be accepted at the email address info@southperthhistoricalsociety.org, up to 5pm on 26May
The written component MS Word 2000 or higher and the photo to be of high resolution. (300 dpi or more).
12. The written entries and selected entries of Special Merit will be mounted, framed and displayed at Heritage House during Heritage Exhibition for a limited time. The selection and mode of display will be at the discretion of the curator. All entries will be retained by the City of South Perth Historical Society and may be used in future promotion of the Award or future heritage displays or publications of the Society. The entrant's name will be acknowledged in all publications of the entry.
13. The judges' decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.

All reasonable care will be taken to protect entries but liability for damage or loss of any entry will not be accepted.
